

TO THE PATRONS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY

Many county patrons/residents find it convenient to push snow from private property and/or driveways onto county road right-of-ways. This action presents potential hazards to the persons driving the roads as well as the county employees; it can also cause monetary damage to private vehicles and county equipment.

Please be advised under County Ordinance 09-03 Section 4 Part C reads, “If an obstruction in the county right-of-way or easement causes damage to any county equipment and/or vehicles during snow removal, road maintenance, or any other scope of county duties, it will be the responsibility of the property owner to reimburse the county for the above mentioned items. The county will not be responsible for any items upon or within the county right-of-way that may become damaged during snow removal, road maintenance, or any other scope of duties.”
