

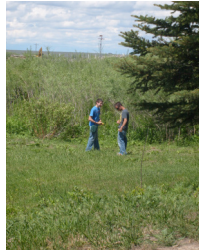
Project List

All of these projects have been made possible by the Upper Snake CWMA. Here is a list of project that Jefferson County did in 2009. Contact us if you would like further information on any of this projects. For information on projects that are planed for 2010 contact us.



Raildogs: Jefferson County teamed up with Madison and Fremont County to help Bonneville County with a mapping and spray project (This has been an on going project for Bonneville County for several years.)

GIS Mapping: Since 2007 the Upper Snake CWMA have had a crew of High School Student mapping Jefferson County for Noxious weeds. This program is important to knowing what weeds are in Jefferson County.



Bio Control Projects: The county uses insects to help control Noxious Weeds. In 2009 we put out Bio control for Leafy Spurge and Canada Thistle

Eurasian Watermilfoil Project: Jefferson county teamed with Bonneville, Madison, and Fremont County to survey Henry's Lake, Mud Lake, and the Snake River for Eurasian Watermilfoil, Zebra/Quagga Mussels, and other invasive aquatic weeds.



Snake River Corridor Spray Days: Since 2008 Jefferson County has held a Spray Days on the Snake River Corridor (by the Menan boat dock). This project has helped control Russian Knapweed and Leafy Spurge in that area. This project also brought to our attention Saltcedar and Rush Skeletonweed which if left uncheck could cause a large problem for that area.
